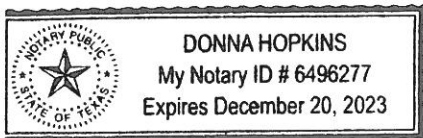

CITY OF
HILLCREST
ADOPTS
TRAILER/RV
ORDINANCE

At the March 14th City
Council Meeting, the
City of Hillcrest Vil-
lage adopted Ordin-
ance 34B-2022 which
is intended to control
the parking of trailers
RVs, campers, and
heavy equipment in the
City of Hillcrest Vil-
lage. According to the
ordinance, to remain
on the property, these
types of equipment
must be parked behind
a six-foot solid fence
unless otherwise ap-
proved by the City
Council. Residents are
allowed to keep the
vehicles temporarily
parked for no more
than seven nights in a
30 day period.

Upon notice of a viola-
tion, residents have 14
days to come into com-
pliance or to make
arrangements to ad-
dress City Council.
Fines of up to \$200.00
per day can be issued if
action is not taken on
the part of the resident.

ordinance is to further
the city's goal to main-
tain and enhance the
visual appearance of
the community, pro-
tect owner's home val-
ues, and protect the
