## Reports/Recommendations from Contractors/Employees:

- A. Caleb MUNICIPAL DISTRICT SERVICES Caleb gave his monthly report. Alderman Smith motioned to authorize MDS to move forward with delinquent accounts. Alderman Mondragon seconded. 4-0 approved and the motion carried.
- B. Shohn Davison MARSHAL'S OFFICE Marshal Davison gave his report. Handled construction concerns, natural gas leak, and assisted with pothole list in addition to their normal duties.

All approved and the motion carried.
