**Hillcrest Village Public Safety Update**

Public safety in Hillcrest Village remains a top priority for the City Council. Comprehensive safety reports are submitted to the Council each month. Some incidents require timely attention, and in those cases, the Marshal's Office notifies the Mayor directly.

This past weekend, the Marshal's Office reported two separate incidents:

1. **Incident involving a non-resident minor:** A minor attempted inappropriate contact with a Hillcrest resident. The Marshal's Office responded, with Alvin Police providing backup. This case is currently under investigation.
2. **Incident involving a new Hillcrest resident:** Two non-residents were involved in an incident with a new resident (rental/lease). The Marshal's Office responded, supported by the Brazoria County Sheriff's Office and Alvin Police Department. This matter is also under investigation.

Both incidents remain under the jurisdiction of the Marshal's Office, and final outcomes will be reported to the Council. At no time was Hillcrest Village's public safety compromised. Law enforcement officers were the first responders and continue working to resolve both matters.

The Hillcrest Village website will provide updates and reports as necessary.
