Ordinance Focus: Let's Talk Limbs!

A beautiful neighborhood starts with beautiful trees! We need your help keeping Hillcrest Village looking sharp and staying safe. Please take a look at your property and trim back any low-hanging tree limbs. Guidelines are 12' minimum off the ground and away from curbs. Keeping branches clear of sidewalks and roads ensures our neighbors can walk safely and emergency vehicles can zip down the street without a hitch!
